

Mentor Dress Code

Bepko Learning Center mentors are representatives of University College. As such, it is preferred that while performing duties for the Bepko Learning Center, mentors dress in business-casual clothing and strive for a professional appearance. Business-casual clothing is defined as clothing that does not distract and does not call attention to itself or to the wearer's physique. An example of business-casual clothing for men would be a button-up or polo shirt and pants. For women, an example would be a button-up shirt or sweater and pants.

Casual clothing is also permitted, provided it is not one of the following articles, which are absolutely **PROHIBITED**:

- Cut-off shorts
- Miniskirts
- Torn, low-rise, frayed, or otherwise revealing jeans
- Tube tops, tank tops, or tops with thin spaghetti straps
- Tops must be of sufficient length so that no midriff skin shows
- Low-cut or plunging necklines
- Undershirts (worn as top shirts)
- Any clothing item described as lingerie
- Any clothing with alcohol or tobacco products, obscene or questionable printing
